INSTRUCTIONS - (Read Carefully)

No camp charter application can be considered unless properly executed by at least seven (7) men who can be a combination of new members, transfers or reinstating former members. The prospective camp must also adopt a camp constitution and bylaws to include with its charter application. GHQ can provide a word file of a sample camp constitution to assist you with this requirement. Charter applications should be prepared in duplicate if your division commander requires a copy. The original should contain the signatures of at least seven eligible applicants for membership along with the signature of the initial camp commander and camp adjutant. The package should first be sent to the division command for his endorsement and signature after which it is sent to the adjutant-in-chief at General Headquarters. Prospective new camps in states where there is no division should mail the charter package to the appropriate Army Department Commander. New member applications, reinstatements and transfer forms must accompany the charter application as provided by Article III, Section 1.3 of the Constitution. Please include the \$20.00 charter application fee along with any applicable dues, new member or reinstatement processing fees. The camp should retain one copy of the charter application forms. Upon completion, the camp charter certificate will normally be sent to the division commander for presentation at an appropriate chartering ceremony.
